- Jimtown Intermediate School will work jointly with parents to develop a Parental Involvement Policy and School-Parent Compact. These documents will be distributed to the parents of Title I students.
- The School-Parent Compact will be designed by parents and school personnel. It will outline the responsibilities of parents, of the school staff, and the student for improving learning.
